Japanese Traditional Instruments

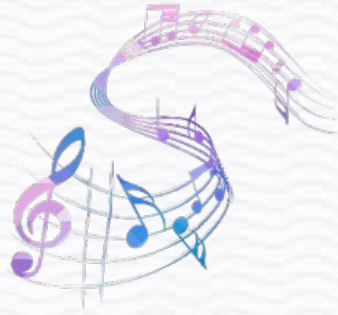

↑ **Shamisen:** The Shamisen is a 3-string lute thought to be variation of the Okinawa sanshin, popularly used in traditional theaters

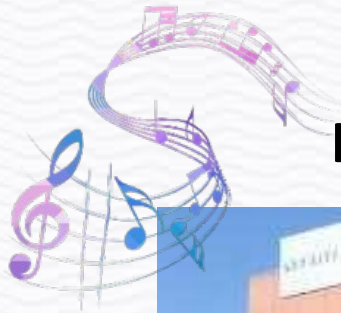

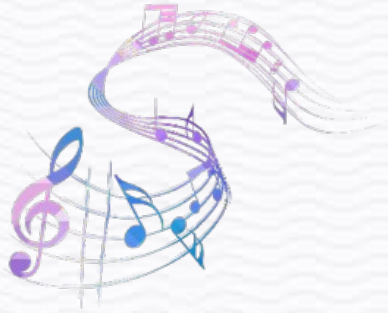
Hamamatsu Museum of Musical Instruments



The Hamamatsu Museum of Musical Instruments is the first municipal museum of musical instruments in Japan. It was established as a part of the Hamamatsu City "Creation of a City of Music" beginning in 1981, and is a registered museum facility under the law of museums.

The mission of the museum is to collect and preserve a representative selection of musical instruments and related materials from around the world, to research them, to exhibit them with an equal and unbiased perspective, and to cultivate a vast knowledge and understanding of music, musical instruments, and culture through a variety of activities.

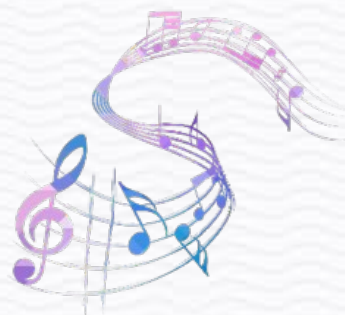




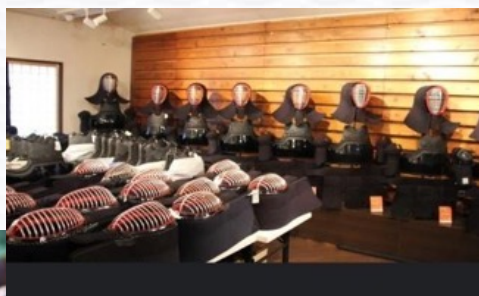
Kyoto: Cultural capital of Japan

Home to numerous Buddhist temples, Shinto shrines, palaces and gardens, many of which are listed collectively by UNESCO as a World Heritage Site.

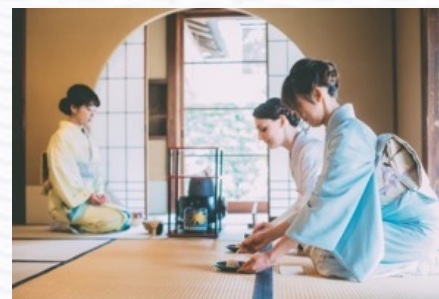




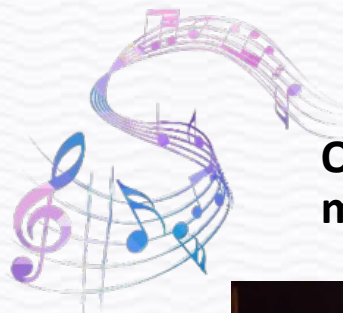

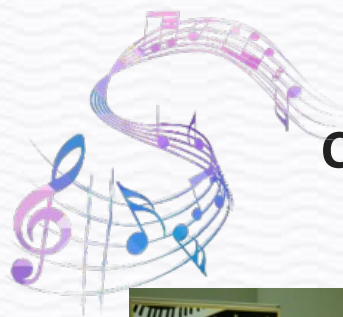
